PEPFAR AT 20

- This year, the U.S. President's Emergency Plan for AIDS Relief (PEPFAR) marks its 20th anniversary of delivering unprecedented impact in the global fight against HIV/AIDS. Since its inception in 2003, PEPFAR has invested nearly \$100 billion in the global HIV/AIDS response, the largest commitment by any nation to address a single disease in history.
- PEPFAR's success is due in large part to its focus on accountability, transparency, impact, and equity. This drives
 constant programmatic improvement and efficiencies, which have allowed for the expansion of life-saving treatment
 to more than 25 million people.

KEY STATS

- SAVING LIVES. PEPFAR has saved an estimated 25 million lives and accelerated progress toward controlling the global HIV/AIDS pandemic in more than 50 countries. AIDS-related deaths have been cut by 64% since their peak in 2004 and new HIV infections have been reduced by 52% since their peak in 1997.
- ADVANCING AN HIV/AIDS-FREE GENERATION. PEPFAR has resulted in 5.5 billion babies born HIV free ensuring children around the world can live healthy and prosperous lives.
- RESILIENT HEALTH CARE SYSTEMS. PEPFAR has helped train 340,000 health care workers to deliver and improve HIV care and other health services, creating resilient health systems in partner countries to confront future health challenges.
